SENIOR PICTURES

- Appointment cards for yearbook photos will be mailed home from Prestige by Lifetouch.
- Senior yearbook pictures taken between July 13-July 15 and July 18-July 22 in upper west gym. You must come at your appointment time and only 1 other person can attend with you.
- You must confirm appointment online.
- If you cannot make your assigned senior yearbook picture time, you can go to the Lifetouch studio or use Picture Retake Day.
- If you bring 2 outfits to your appointment, your sitting fee is free. Otherwise sitting fee is \$10.00 for yearbook picture. Use discount code 9ZKQ
- Pictures taken on Oriole Preview Day are for the student ID only; <u>the assigned</u> <u>appointment time is for seniors'</u> <u>yearbook photo.</u>
- Students should dress nicely for the yearbook photo. Shirt/tie or nice dress/top are acceptable. Shoulders and chest must be covered; strapless, low necklines and spaghetti straps are not allowed.

IMMUNIZATIONS

Immunization Requirement for all 12th Graders in 2022-2023

- Students in 12th grade are required to provide documentation of the following:
- Second Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine (if their first MCV4 vaccine was given before the age of 16). Students who received the first MCV4 vaccine on or after their 16th birthday have met the requirements
- Two doses of Hepatitis A (Hep A) vaccine
- If your student has had these vaccinations, please send a copy via: fax (317-544-5029), email <u>dlwoernle@avon-schools.org</u> bring copy to Oriole Preview Day or to the clinic when school starts.
- Seniors must have shots by <u>Sept. 6, 2022</u> with updated records presented to clinic or they will be excluded from school.
- A shot clinic will be available during Oriole Preview Days in the AHS Cafeteria.
- Please bring your insurance card. Private insurance and Medicaid is accepted. Self pay is not available.
- Shots that will be offered:
 - ♦ Hepatitis A
 - ♦ Meningococcal (MCV4)
 - ♦ Meningitis B
 - ♦ HPV
