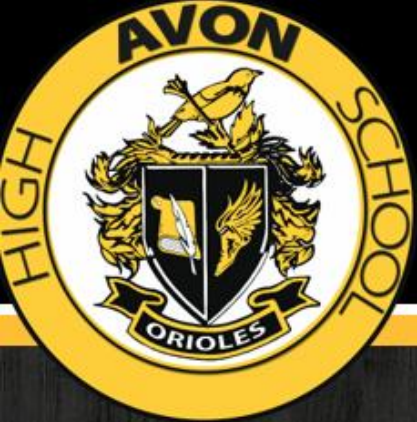

Tip: Have a pick-up plan...communicate which door you will pick up your child up after orientation and school days.





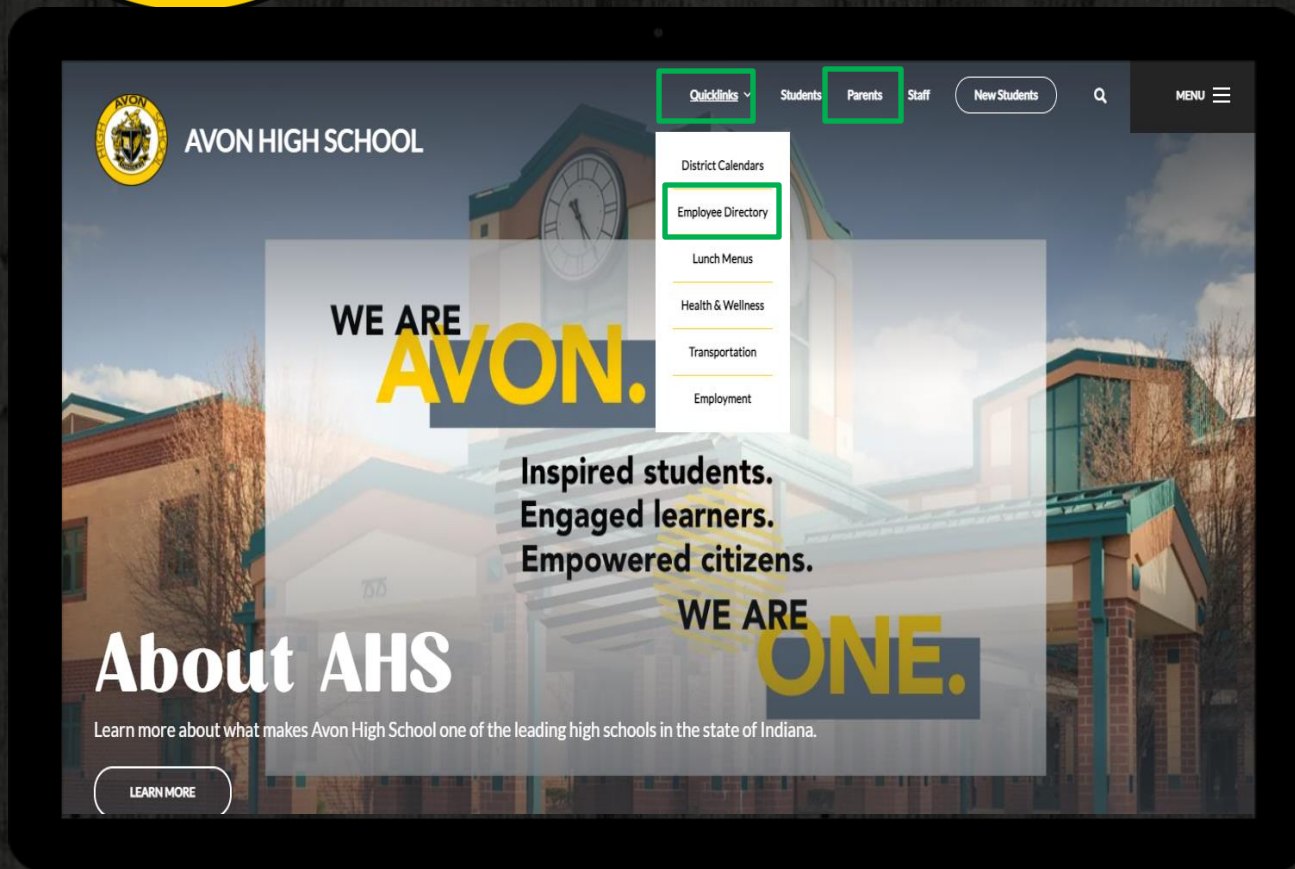
